

# RESEARCH in RESIDENCY MINI-GRANT APPLICATION

## GOAL

- To improve and sustain the Residency Project curriculum and infrastructure by supporting residents as they pursue their Residency Projects.

## GRANT SIZE

- Up to \$1000 per project (irrespective of the number of residents working on the project).

## ELIGIBILITY

- Residents must be in good standing within the Pediatric Residency Program at the University of Chicago. (Medicine-Pediatrics and other Combined-degree residents who opt to fulfill the Residency Project requirements are also eligible.)
- Projects must be consistent with the requirements of the Residency Project curriculum -- **health-related** and **pursued in a scholarly manner**.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- Preference will be given to applications that demonstrate how the Mini-Grant would contribute to the sustainability of the residents' current project beyond their graduation and/or how it paves the way for future successful projects.
- Decisions will be made by Mentor Committee members as a group.

## APPLICATION CYCLE

- Ongoing throughout the year.
